They were joined by Jean Beliveau and Henri Richard who were also displayed in the $1960-61$ series. These latest tumblers measured $43 / 4$ inches tall and were produced by Dominion Glass as indicated with a "D" on the bottom.


## 1967-68 YORK PEANUT BUTTER GLASSES

Hockey interest in the Canadiens again surfaced in a York peanut butter promotion for 1967-68. These glass tumblers measured $53 / 4$ inches tall to hold the autographed Canadiens players photograph, name and number. Players featured are Henri Richard, Jean-Claude Tremblay and Lorne Worsley. In addition, two tumblers were made for each player as each had a different penalty on the reverse side. Both plastic and tin lids were found on tumblers this year.
